Feeder steers and heifers have no comparison due to light receipts last week. Trade active, demand moderate. The supply consisted of dairy steers weighing 325-400 lbs for Current thru September Delivery, along with feeders weighing 625-800 lbs for Current Delivery. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (0.8% Steers, 98.2% Dairy Steers, 1% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 1%. Unless otherwise stated, prices fob shipping point with 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent with 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weight. Delivered prices include freight, commissions and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from CA, ID, TX.
