Utilization of Producer Milk in Class III Products is the monthly volume of milk used to produce Class III Fluid Milk products.

The monthly All Markets Combined row is the total volume of milk used to produce Class III Fluid Milk products for each month.

The year-to-date (YTD) column is the total volume of milk used to produce Class III Fluid Milk products for each individual Federal Milk Marketing Order and for all Orders combined.

Class III Utilization Percentage of Producer Milk is the monthly volume of Class III Milk used to produce

The monthly All Markets Combined percentage line is the total volume of milk used to produce Class III Fluid Milk products for each month divided by total volume of milk pooled that month.

The year-to-date (YTD) column is the total of milk used to produce Class III Fluid Milk products for each

Butterfat Test of Producer Milk Used in Class III Products is the percentage of butterfat found in the Class III Milk for each Federal Milk Marketing Order for each month.

The All Markets Combined line is the percentage of butterfat found in the total Class III Milk for all Federal Milk Marketing Orders for the month.

The year-to-date (YTD) column is the percentage of butterfat found in the total Class III Milk for each individual Federal Milk Marketing Order and for all Orders combined.


