



Certifying Agent Acronyms for TM-11 Export Certificates

When exported to Japan and Taiwan, U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) organic products must be accompanied by a TM-11 Export Certificate. The TM-11 Export Certificate verifies that the product complies with the terms of the trade arrangement.

Taiwan

Accredited certifying agents (certifiers) must be approved by the USDA to issue TM-11 Export Certificates for exports going to Taiwan. The following certifiers are authorized to issue TM-11 Export Certificates, and are assigned the following acronyms:

All USDA-accredited certifiers may issue TM-11 Export Certificates to Japan for products produced, or where final packaging occurs, in the United States.

Certifiers who are approved to issue TM-11 Export Certificates to Taiwan should use the acronyms assigned above for TM-11 Export Certificates to Japan. Other certifiers may request a code from the National Organic Program Accreditation and International Activities Division.
